Cristo Rey Oklahoma City Catholic High School (Cristo Rey OKC) is a Catholic college preparatory school that educates diverse students of all faiths to become men and women of knowledge, faith, purpose, and service. Our rigorous academic curriculum and Corporate Work Study Program equips students to succeed in college and life. Cristo Rey OKC opened its doors in August 2018. Approximately 73% of former students are currently pursuing college degrees. 75 % of our students qualify for free/reduced lunch and 82% of our students are first-generation college students.

Corporate Work Study (CWS) Program

The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is an integral part of the student's educational experience at Cristo Rey OKC. The program provides unique professional work and "hands-on" learning opportunities for our students five days a month. After completing our Summer Success Training program students are prepared for the workplace, and they are placed with some of Oklahoma City's top corporations, including law firms, hospitals, banks, non-profits, and other businesses. Through CWSP students gain valuable professional experience in a variety of fields, develop specialized skills, and establish meaningful professional connections and mentoring relationships giving them a competitive edge in college and their careers.

Cristo Rey OKC's rigorous college preparatory curriculum includes several AP courses.

Juniors and Seniors are given the opportunity to pursue concurrent enrollment as another challenge to prepare them for university-level coursework prior to college matriculation. They are allowed the option to enroll in one course per semester. Juniors will take their concurrent courses at Rose State College, and seniors will take their concurrent courses at the University of Oklahoma.

Math at Cristo Rey OKC

Cristo Rey OKC offers three math tracks. The advanced track, for students who completed Algebra 1 in 8th grade, culminates in Calculus senior year. A second track serves STEM-focused students who begin Algebra 1 in 9th grade and progress to Pre-Calculus with Trigonometry. The third track is for non-STEM students and concludes with Algebra 3 (College Algebra equivalent), preparing them for the CLEP exam. Math 1, 2, and 3 align with Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2.
