Cristo Rey Oklahoma City Catholic High School (Cristo Rey OKC) is a Catholic college preparatory school that educates diverse students of all faiths to become men and women of knowledge, faith, purpose, and service. Our rigorous academic curriculum and Corporate Work Study Program equips students to succeed in college and life.

Cristo Rey OKC opened its doors in August 2018. Approximately 78% of former students are currently pursuing college degrees. 72% of our students qualify for free/reduced lunch and 78% of our students are first-generation college students.

A Student at Cristo Rey OKC are required to take at least 32 credits over their four years. Cristo Rey OKC's curriculum will also include Advanced Placement (AP) courses. (1 credit = 1 full year of instruction)

AP & Concurrent Enrollment

Cristo Rey OKC's rigorous college preparatory curriculum includes several AP courses.

Juniors and Seniors are given the opportunity to pursue concurrent enrollment as another challenge to prepare them for university-level coursework prior to college matriculation. They are allowed the option to enroll in one course per semester. Prior to this year, students took courses at Oklahoma State University-Oklahoma City. This year, juniors will take their concurrent courses at Rose State College, and seniors will take their concurrent courses at the University of Oklahoma.

Math at Cristo Rey OKC

We have three math tracks for students at Cristo Rey OKC. One track is for students who took Algebra 1 in 8th grade and will take Calculus their senior year. Very few students are on this track due to the lack of students with the opportunity, from many of our feeder schools, to take Algebra 1 in 8th grade. Another track is for students interested in STEM who were not able to take Algebra 1 in 8th grade and will take Pre-Calculus (which includes trigonometry) their senior year. The other track is for students who have not identified an interest in STEM, and they will take Algebra 3, equivalent to College Algebra, in their senior year. They are preparing to take the CLEP exam at the end of their course. Completing Math 1, 2, and 3 is equivalent to completing Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2 in a 3-year sequence.
